Subscription Option to allow teacher accounts to edit document locks in Kurzweil 3000 for Web Browsers (www.Kurzweil3000.com).

Subscription Option to allow or disallow teacher (SLC) accounts to edit document locks in files.

- Login with the Top Level Coordinator login
- Go to **My Account > Subscription Options**
- In Settings, check the box to turn on **Allow SLC users to edit document feature locks**

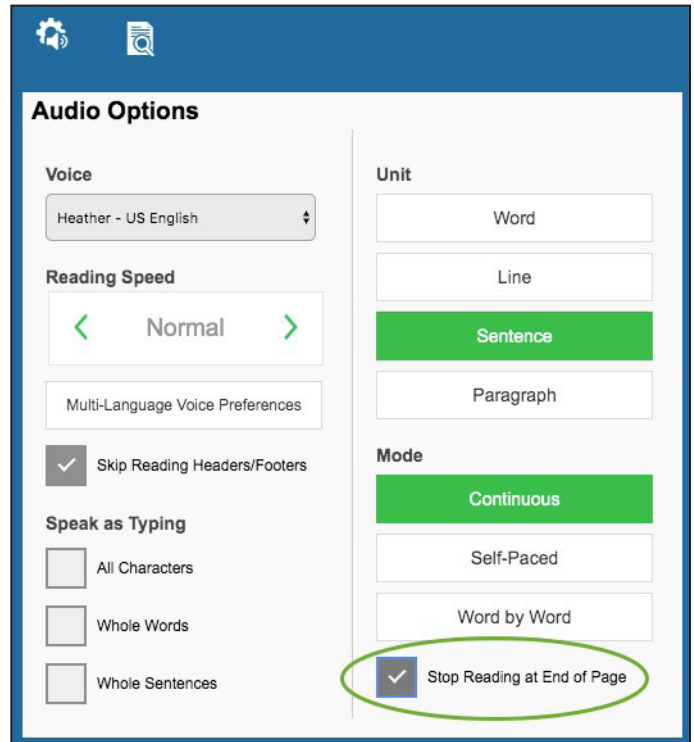

Check the box for **Stop Reading at End of Page**.

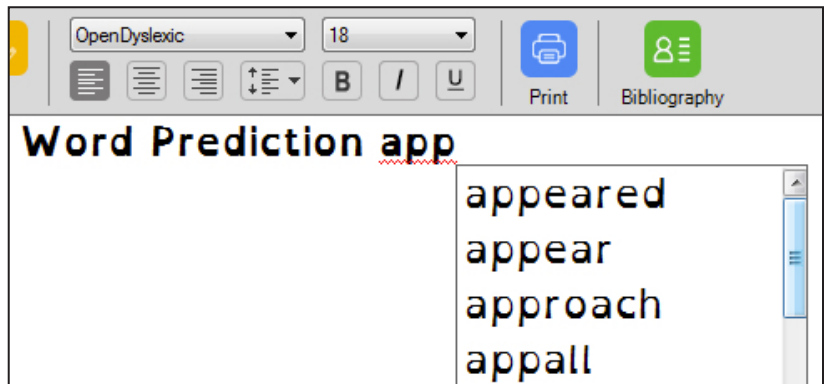
Downloading a file or saving it to Google Drive now saves up to 50 pages in Kurzweil 3000 for Web Browsers (www.Kurzweil3000.com).

When in an image file, choosing Save to Google Drive in the Save menu or downloading (to a non-kes format) automatically saves up to 50 pages, from the page you're viewing.
